- 1. Approval of minutes: Linda Schamber moved to approve the minutes of the July 16 meeting. Donna O'Dania seconded. Passed unanimously.
- Friends of the Library update: Donna Pierce reported. Keith Klenke, president, and Karen _____, secretary, are resigning, leaving only Mimi _____, treasurer. The fundraising organization will have to be rebuilt. We should recruit members at upcoming public events.
- 3. Library update by Donna Pierce
 - Monthly statistics were distributed. The July gate count of 1,259 was excellent.
 - The summer reading program was successful and stretched the limits of the space. The library can attract and accommodate up to 60 children without advertising.
 - Donna Pierce taught a cataloging workshop for the North Texas Library Consortium on August 19.
- 4. Policy action items
 - Six revised policy documents were distributed and discussed: Donation Policy, Unattended Children Policy, General Customer Behavior Expectations, Customer Service Standards, Privacy Policy, and Services to Persons with Disabilities.
 - Linda Schamber moved to accept the policies as written. Kevin Fikes seconded. Passed unanimously.
- 5. Design of sign for future home of library: Kelly suggested this be a more durable sign than the last.
- 6. Vision for new library building: discussion deferred until next meeting.
- 7. Planning committee for new library building: Donna Pierce will ask Mayor Terri Wilson about her expectations for membership. The Library Board would like to have members with expertise and/or experience regarding library architecture and functions. The presentation on building contract processes at the August 5 City Council meeting, which was attended by five Library Board members, was informational only and not focused on library buildings.
- 8. Fundraising ideas for the Celebrate Krum event on October 5: Donna Pierce has three bags of stuffed animals that could be used for game prizes. She suggested that this be a joint fundraiser with the Library Board and Friends of the Library.
