- 3. Update from Library Director
 - A. Monthly Statistics

Total gate count for August was 1243, with an average daily count of 54. The only program held in August was the Movie Discussion Club.

B. Summer Reading Program Statistics

A total of 1121 people attended 52 programs over the summer.

C. Update on budget

It looks like we will have more funds for supplies and collection development. No raise for staff other than cost of living. Mayor did state that we would need to revise budget after new library opens, and we would need to add full-time staff.

4. Election of Officers

All current officers were willing to remain, rest of board was fine with that. Adrienne Pohrte made the motion that we retain current officers, Pamela Gregory second and all approved.

5. Review of Library Polices and Charter

Other than a few typos no changes were made to the policies or charter. The director will make the minor changes and marked all as reviewed 9/20/16
